Introduction

The Navigation macro allows you to display a part of the SubSpace navigation or the complete navigation on a Confluence page. It is displayed as an indented list.

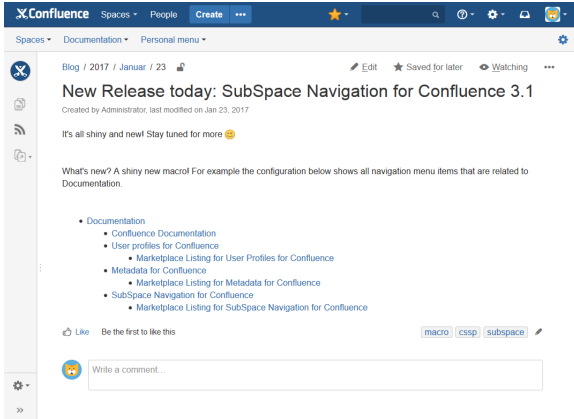


Image 1: Navigation macro (click to enlarge)

Parameters

The Navigation macro comes with parameters to make the macro fit your needs. You can find them listed in the table below.

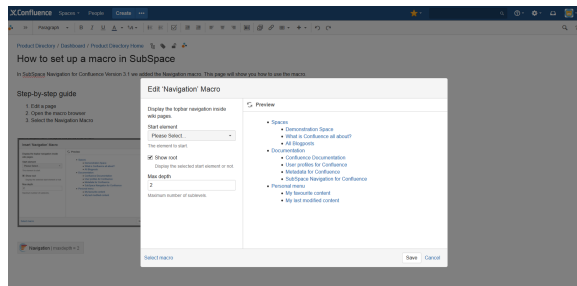


Image 2: Configuration of the Navigation macro (click to enlarge)

Parameter	Default	Description
Start element	None	Select a navigation element from the dropdown list. The Navigation macro will display all navigation elements below the selected start element. The start element will be displayed as well, if you check "show root" (see next parameter).
Show root	Selected	If selected, the macro will display the start element as the first element in the list.
Max depth	None	Here you can configure how many hierarchy levels the macro should display. If you do not set any value, all navigation points will be displayed.
